Why Plastic Bags Don't Belong in Promenade's Recycling Bins

- **They Jam the Machines** – Plastic bags get tangled in the sorting equipment at recycling facilities, causing costly shutdowns and delays.
- **They Contaminate Recyclables** – Bags can wrap around other recyclable materials, making them unusable.

What We CAN Recycle at Promenade

- Paper (newspapers, magazines, cardboard)
- Aluminum cans
- Glass bottles and jars
- Plastic bottles and containers

What to Do with Plastic Bags

- **Reuse Them** – Use them for shopping, pet waste, or other household needs.
- **Return Them To Designated Collection Points** – Many grocery stores have collection bins specifically for plastic bags.
- **Avoid Them Whenever Possible** – Use reusable shopping bags instead.
